

## **2014 Heartland Classic**

### **Day 4**

**June 20, 2014**

**Norman-** Team Texas (5-1) advanced to their fourth consecutive Heartland Baseball Classic Championship Game Friday evening, after defeating Team Oklahoma 7-1 at Norman North High School, a day after play was suspended due to rain.

The defending champs will play Team Maryland (4-2) whom advanced to the title game after a tie-breaking scenario was enacted.

Team Arkansas finished their pool-play with only one win in the tournament, but there was room to be optimistic. Before falling to Georgia by a score of 9-4, Arkansas pulled within a run in the fifth inning before costly errors would allow Georgia to pounce. The same would happen in their 10-6 loss to team Ohio. Arkansas gave up five errors against Ohio, but would make a late rally in the sixth and seventh inning that would come up short.

Ohio split their afternoon games, defeating Arkansas 10-6, but would lose to Team Maryland 6-5. Ohio gave up five runs in the second inning.

Maryland finished the day off with an 11-0 victory over team Colorado who finished the tournament 1-6.

Team Colorado played Texas very close in their first game of the day, giving the defending champs quite the scare. Texas would go on to win 7-3.
